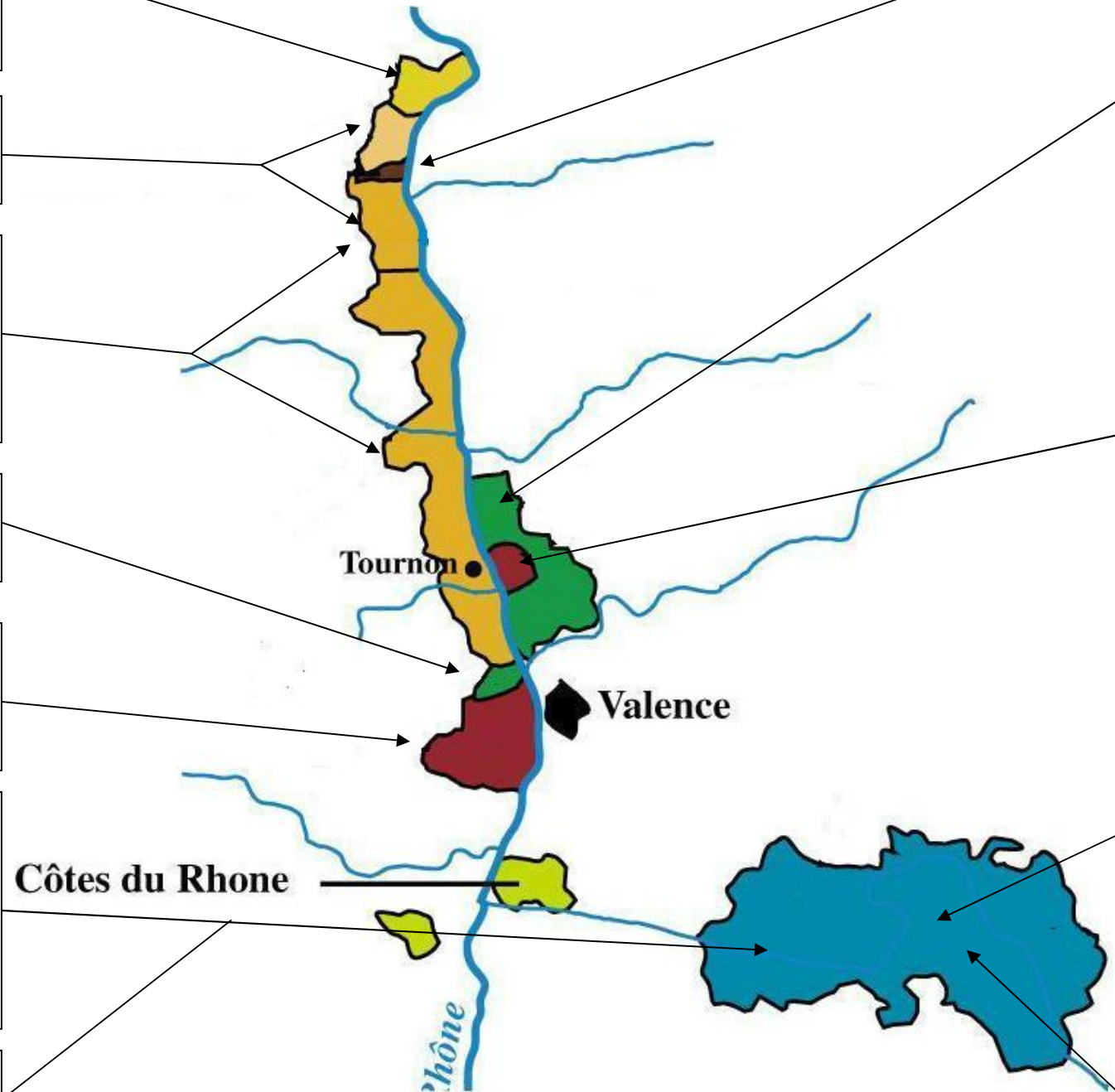

Clairette de Die AC
 Muscat with up to 30% Clairette
 Min 9% abv
 RS: min 55g/l
 Clairette de Die Methode Ancestrale Dioise - After pressing, must is kept below zero until it reaches 3%. It is then bottled and second fermentation takes place in bottle. After at least four months on the lees, it is cleared and sealed. No dosage permitted.

Cremant de Die AC
 100% Clairette brut wines made in the traditional method. Until 1999 called Clairette de Die Brut
 Min 9% abv
 Other reds and whites labeled at Chatillon-en-Dios

Côte Rôtie AC
 Based upon Schistous south-facing river bend above the town of Ampuis
 Notable Climat: Cote Brune, Cote Blonde and Cote Rozier Syrah with up to 20% Viognie
 Max Yield: 40hl/ha
 Min 10% abv

Condrieu AC
 100% Viognier
 Max yield: 37hl/ha
 Min 11% abv

St. Joseph AC
 Min 10% abv
 Max yield: 40hl/ha
Whites
 Roussanne with max 10% Marsanne
Reds
 Min 80% Syrah with max10% Roussanne and Marsanne

Cornas AC
 Reds from 100% Syrah
 Max yield: 40hl/ha
 Min 10.5% abv

St. Peray AC
 Primarily sparkling wine from Marsanne and Roussanne using Methode Traditionelle
 Max yield: 45hl/ha
 Min 10% abv for still and 9.5% abv

Chatillon-en-Dios AC
 Diois region around the town of Die
 Made by the co-operative of Die.
Red and Rosé
 Min 10% abv
 Min 75% Gamay with the remainder being Pinot Noir and Syrah.
White
 Min 10.5% abv
 Aligote and Chardonnay

Côteaux de Die AC
 An appellation for dry Clairette.
